

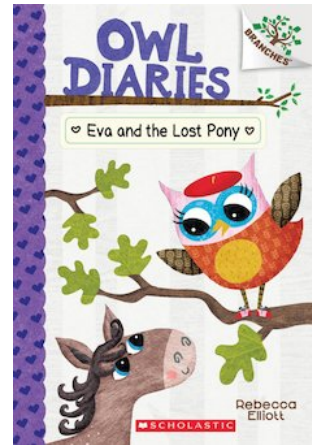

Eva And The Lost Pony (Branches: Owl Diaries)

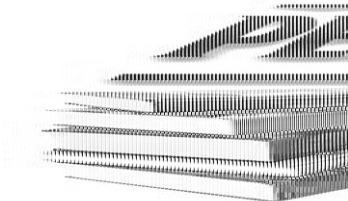

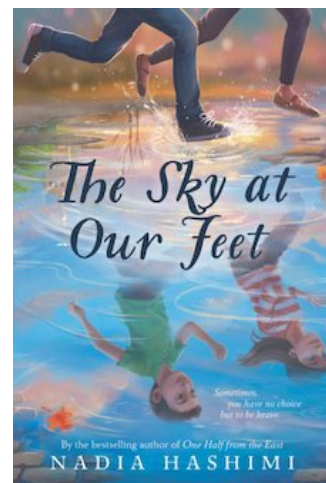
